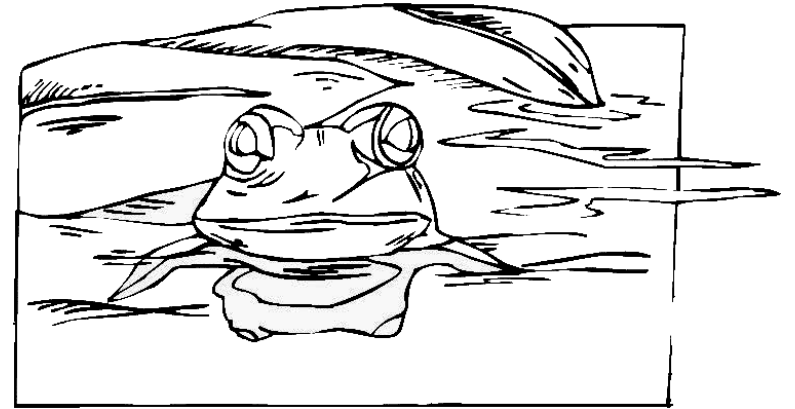
Tadpoles hatch from eggs in the water. First, they are like little fish, and then they develop legs and a head.

Frogs hibernate through the winter. They hide under a log or in the mud at the bottom of a pond.

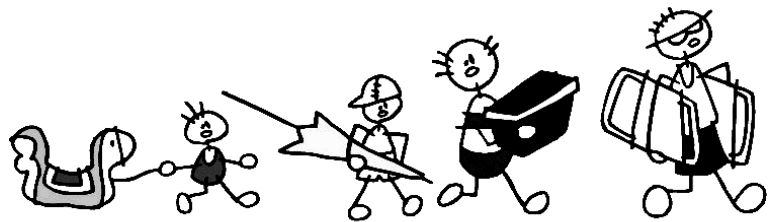

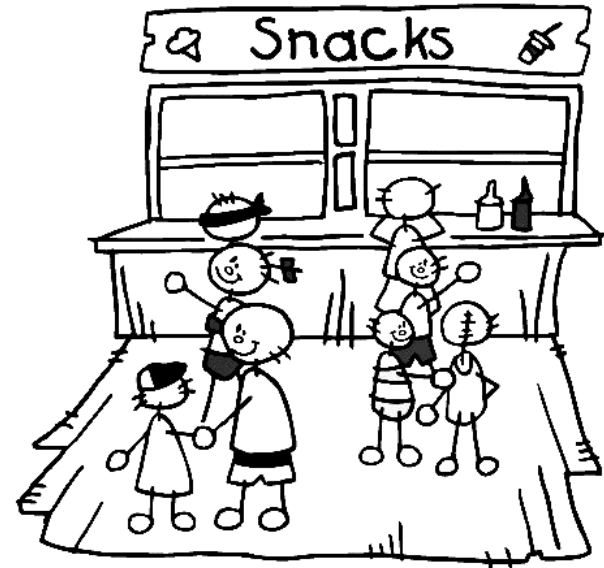

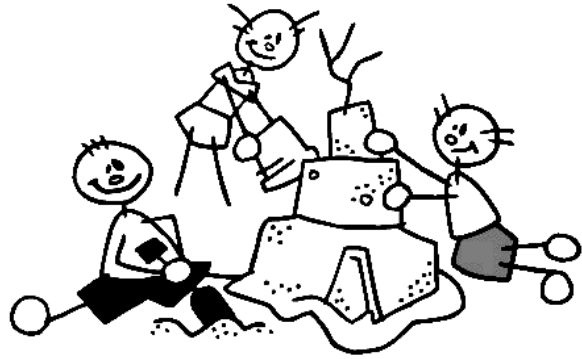
I love the beach! I like sandy beaches and rocky beaches. I like the beach at the lake and the beach at the ocean.

I like to go to the beach with my family and I like to play at the beach with my friends. I always bring my swimsuit and sunscreen and a hat!



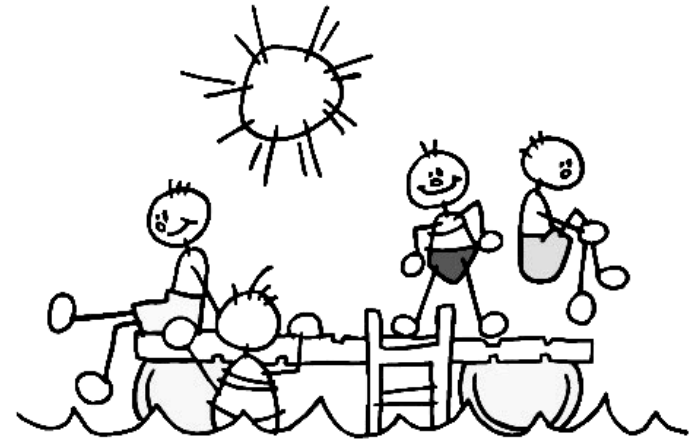
At the end of the day Mom takes us to the snack bar to get ice cream. I like the orange ice cream and my sister likes the bubble gum.

We use our shovels and pails and we get really dirty. Mom tells us to take a dip in the water to get clean!

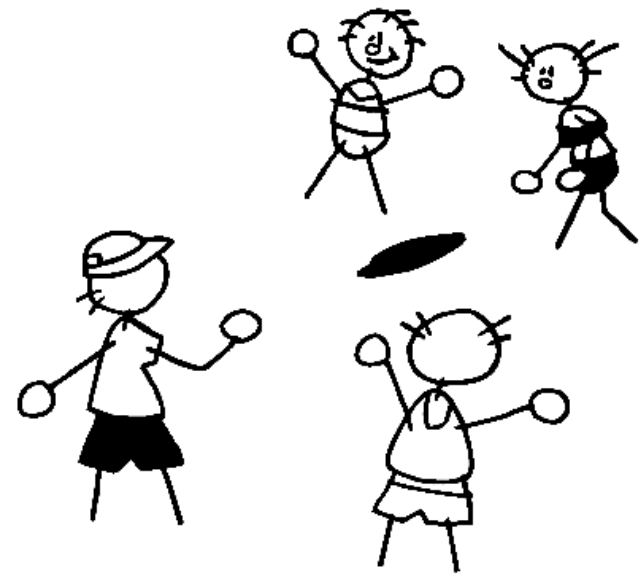

Sometimes the Frisbee goes into the water. We ask Mom or Dad if we can swim out and get it. My friend's dog likes to play Frisbee at the beach, too!



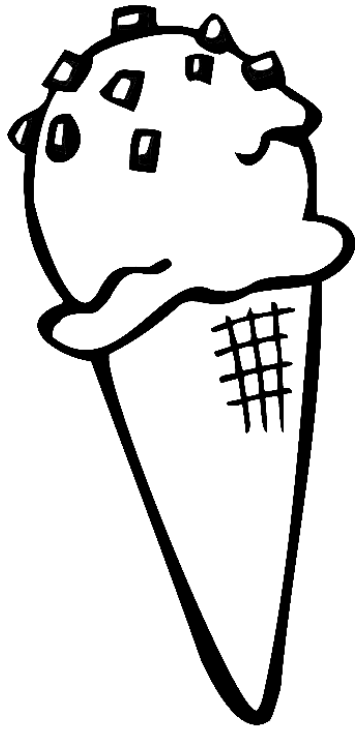

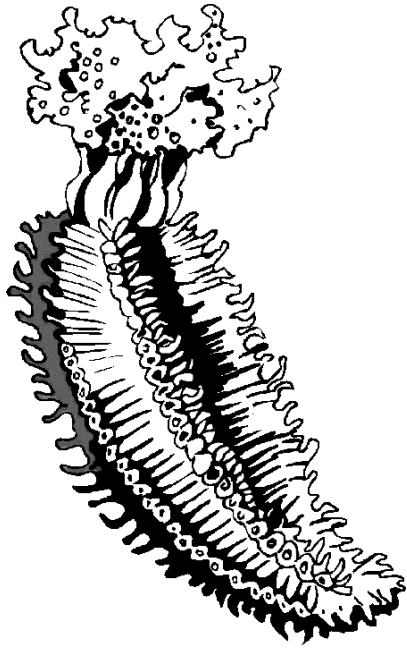
What can you find when the tide goes out?

Starfish are called echinoderms. What does that mean?



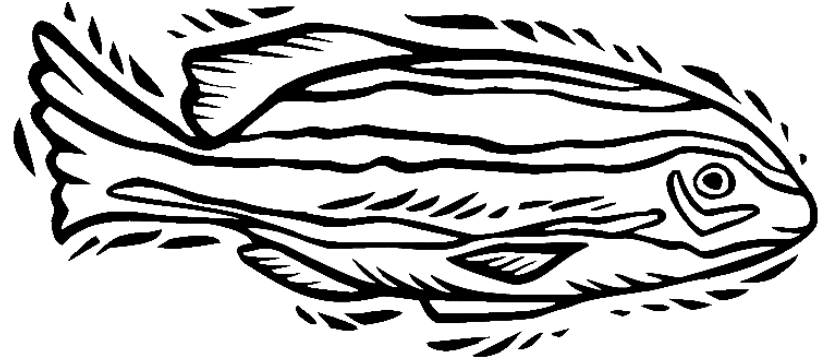

Under a big rock, you could see a sea cucumber. A sea cucumber is an echinoderm, like a starfish. Sea cucumbers eat algae and bits of plant life in the sea. Sea cucumbers can be different colours, but many are a reddish colour.

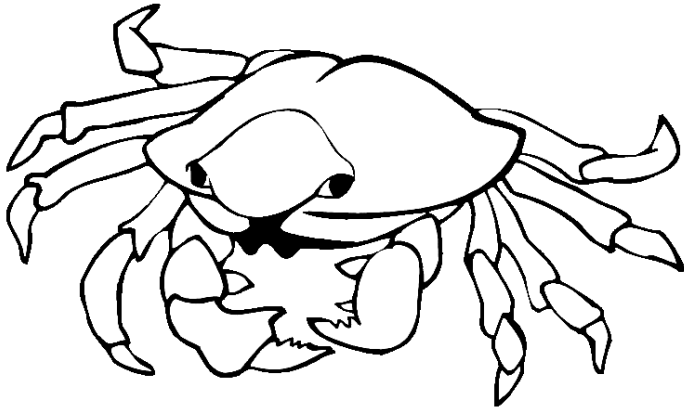
A sea cucumber is shaped like a tube — like a cucumber!

How big is a sea cucumber?



Under the rocks you might find little blennies. Blennies are little fish that live in both the Pacific and Atlantic oceans. They eat algae and barnacles. Blennies move fast when you lift up the rock!

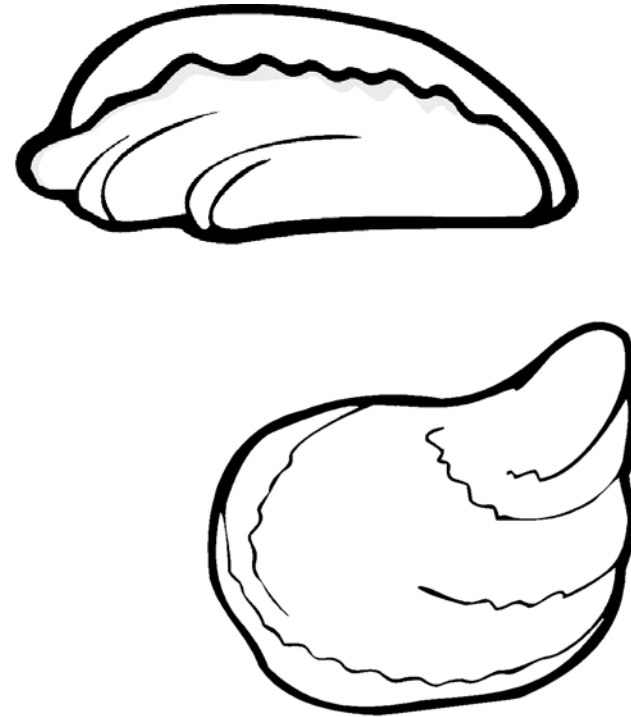
Why are the blennies under the rocks?



Under rocks you might find little crabs. Crabs are arthropods. What does that mean?

All crabs have 8 walking legs and two claws. They walk sideways. Crabs breathe underwater using gills. They eat tiny algae and plankton.

How big can crabs grow?



When the tide goes out, you may see oysters. An oyster bed is a place where many oysters live.

Oysters belong to a group called mollusks. Clams are mollusks, too. Oysters have gills. Oysters eat algae. Starfish and humans eat oysters.
