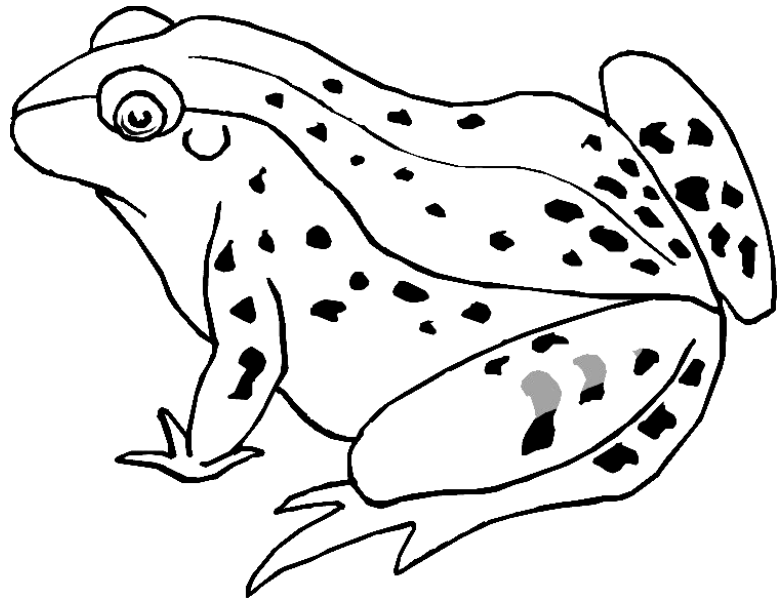

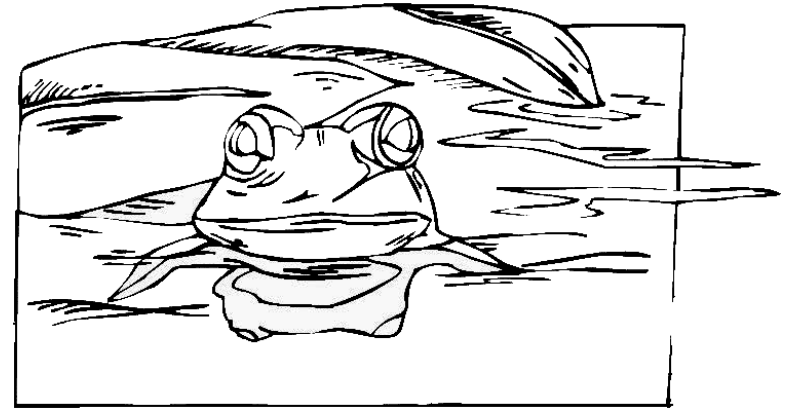
Tadpoles hatch from eggs in the water. First, they are like little fish, and then they develop legs and a head.
