



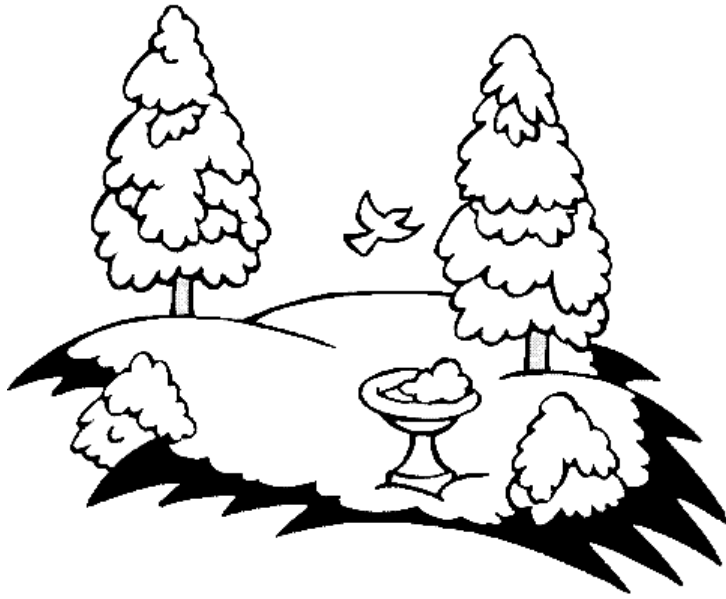

Pam will shovel snow off the paths. It will be hard work, but it will be fun, too.

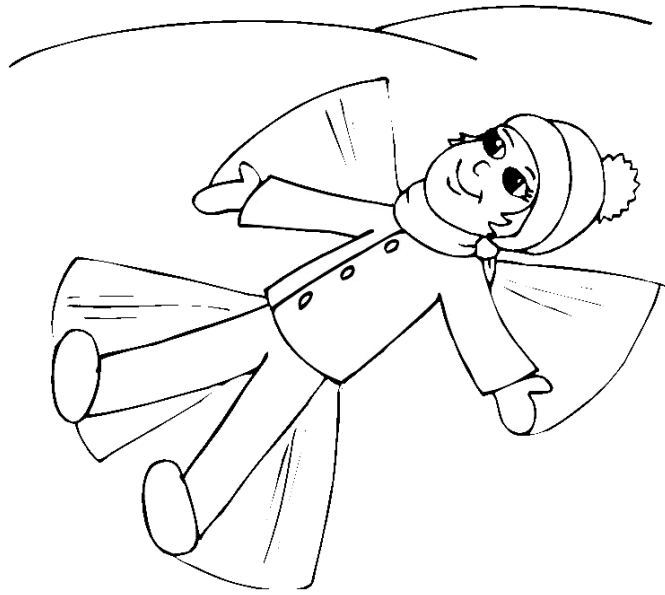
It will help the family. Then Pam will go to her granny's house and shovel the snow from her paths, too.

We had a lot of fun!



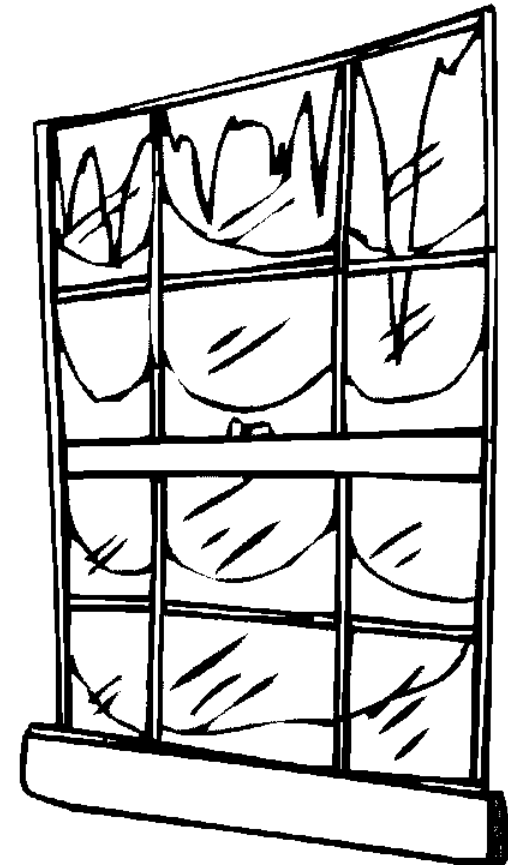
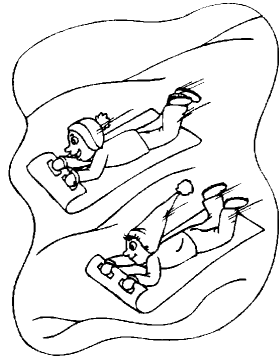
Then I wanted to make a

Mom and Dad were scared.



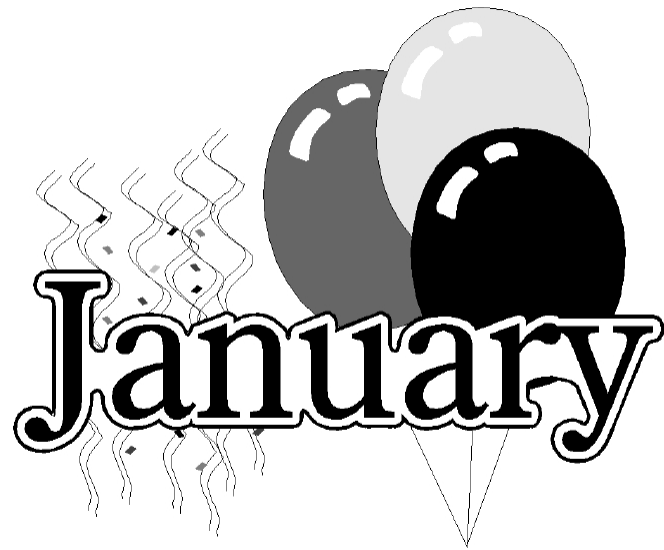
Then I got my sled.

the hill, but that was OK.



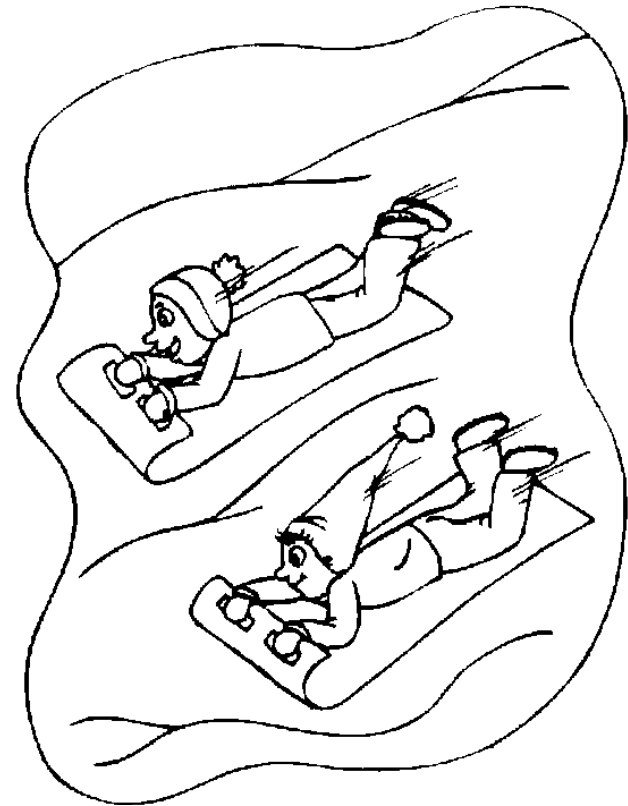
My sister came outside to

we threw snowballs.



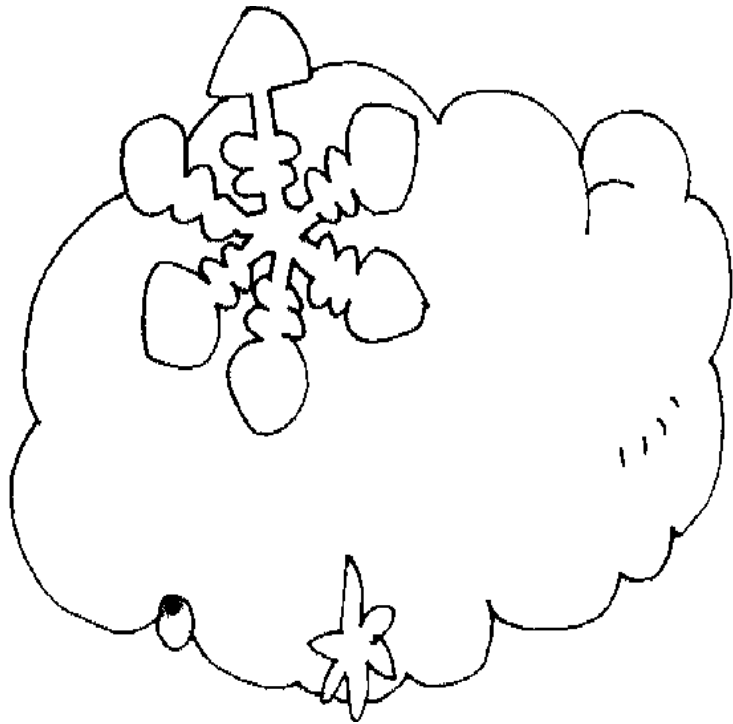
