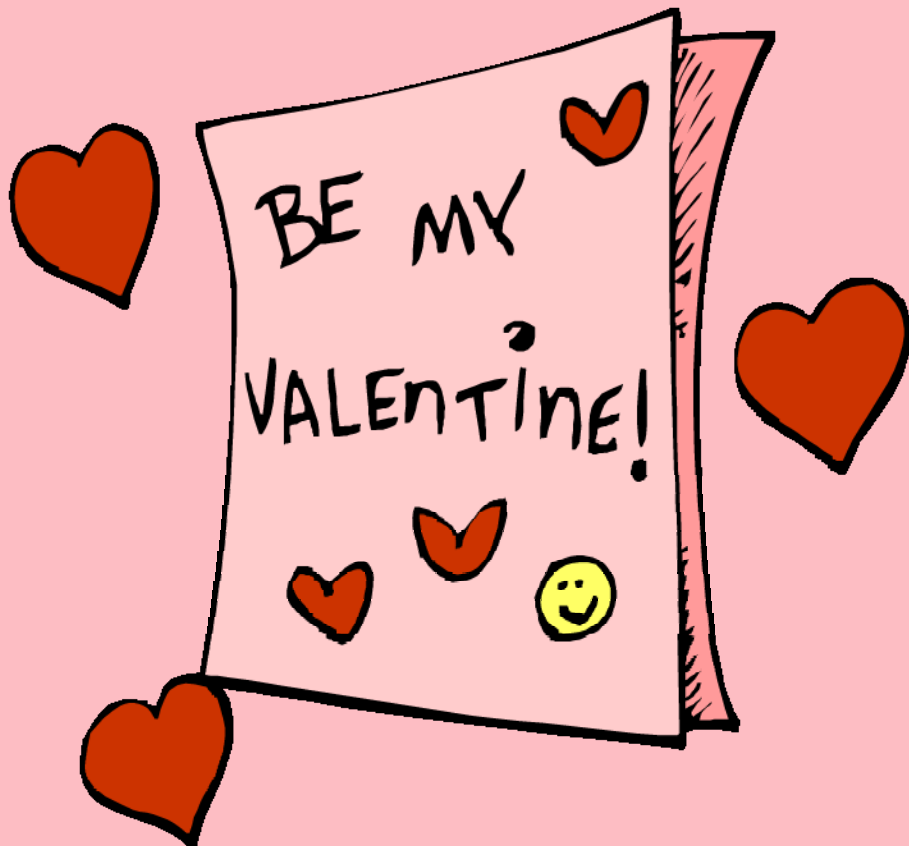




Valentine Poems

Pink! Pink!

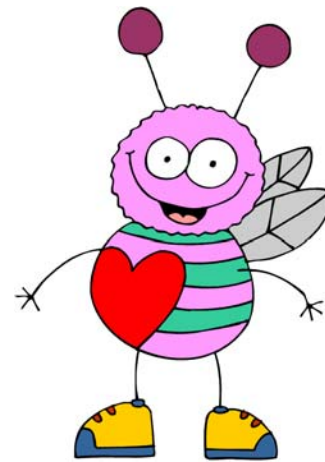
Our favourite colour

I'll take you for my valentine!

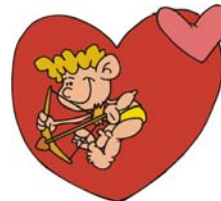
Making Valentines
