Ideas for Teaching the November Dolch Words

Lesson 15. me, we, it, in, for

Teach **me** and **we**. They look alike and rhyme, of course. Have the cards with these words, and have one child hold **me**, and two or more children hold the **we** card. Ask which one would be right for different sized groups.

We have had the word *is*, and you will likely have taught the letter sounds of /t/ and /n/, so *it* and *in* should be easy. Teach *for*, and show *for me, for you, for the cat, for my birthday*.

Read It is in the house. It is for me. We like to play with you.

Use the words in sentences and read the sentence page.

16. look, not, one, fun

Review the words in lesson 15, and others that the students have difficulty remembering.

Introduce the word 'look'. Draw eyes in the o's.- Look at me! Look at my cat. I like to look at fish.

Teach not. My sister is not here. The cat is not in the house.

Teach one - one girl, one boy, one car, one boat, etc.

Teach fun - It is fun to go with you in the car. It is not fun to go in the boat.

Read the sentence sheet.

17. good, have, funny

Review the words in all the previous lessons.

Introduce the word *good*, and the sentences *It is a good day*. The little girl has good toys. Look at the good game!

Introduce *have*. Discuss the /h/ sound. Have the students give you oral sentences with *have*, and point to the word. Show these sentences: *We can have fun*. *I like to have a good day*.

Introduce *funny*. Show the word fun, and have the students circle the word *fun* in *funny*. Show sentences: My little sister is funny. I see a funny car. It is a funny fish.

Print sentences from the sentence page on a chart. Give out the sentence page, and read all the sentences. Touch under each word as you read.

18. yes, no, morning, mother

Review the words previously taught.

Teach the words <u>yes</u> and <u>no</u>. Give your students each a yes and a no card and ask questions, and they hold up the correct card answer.

Introduce the word <u>morning</u>. Discuss the sound of /m/. Read the sentences: *I go* to school in the morning. We have a good morning at school.

Teach the word mother. Show the picture card and post it. Mother can see me playing. I will come here in the car with my mother.

Print sentences from the sentence page on a chart. See the sentence page, and read all the sentences. Touch under each word as you read.

19. snow, snowing, run, jump

Review the words previously taught.

Show the words **snow** and **snowing**. Isolate the 'ing'. Read the words **seeing**, **going**, **playing**, **fishing**, **looking**. If your students are ready - also read **liking**, **naming**, and **having**.

Show the words *run* and *jump*. Discuss the motions, and do them when showed the cards. Read: *It is snowing! I like to run and jump in the snow*.

Print sentences from the sentence page on a chart. See the sentence page, and read all the sentences. Touch under each word as you read.

20. home, said, are

Review the words previously taught.

Show the word *home*. Read *go home*, *come home my home*

Said is a tricky word! Use it with each of your students' names - Michael said, "It's snowing!" Put it with the words previously taught: I said, you said, we said, Mother said, my brother said, my sister said, etc.


Are is a bit tricky, too! Talk about the 'r' in the middle. Read: we are here, you and I are here, Mother and I are going, the dog and cat are little, etc.
