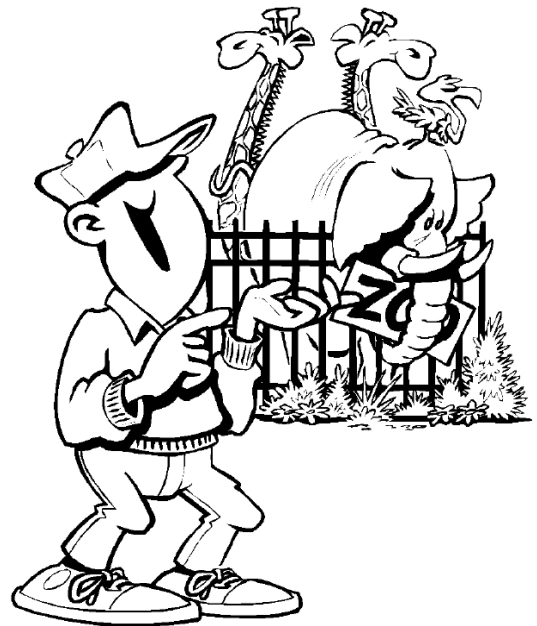


I went to the zoo

So then there was just one.

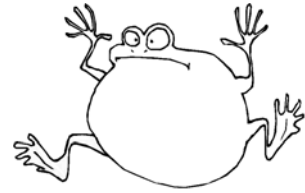
One little frisky frog

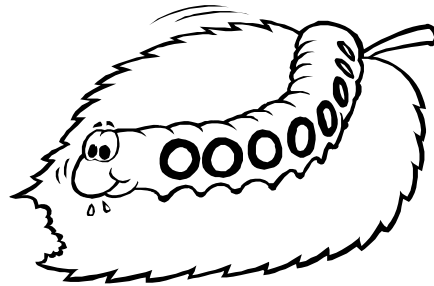
Sitting on a stone.

So he won't be alone.

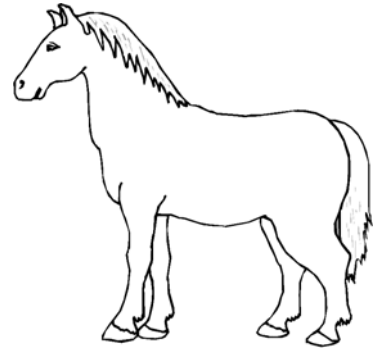
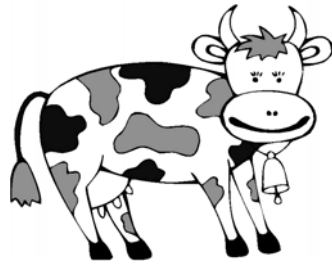




Caterpillar Song

And be a butterfly!

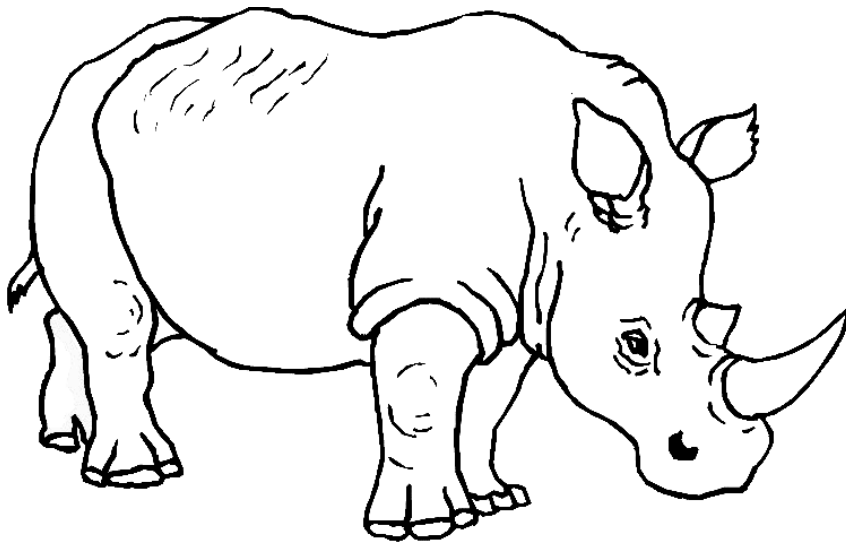


Helpers

Rhinoceros

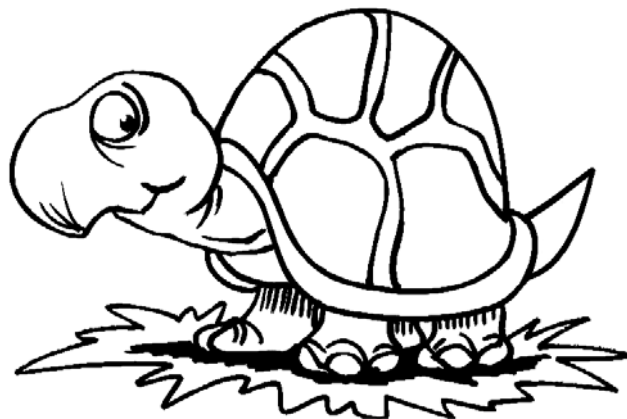
A rhinoceros, rhinoceros.

You can't make a turtle come out.

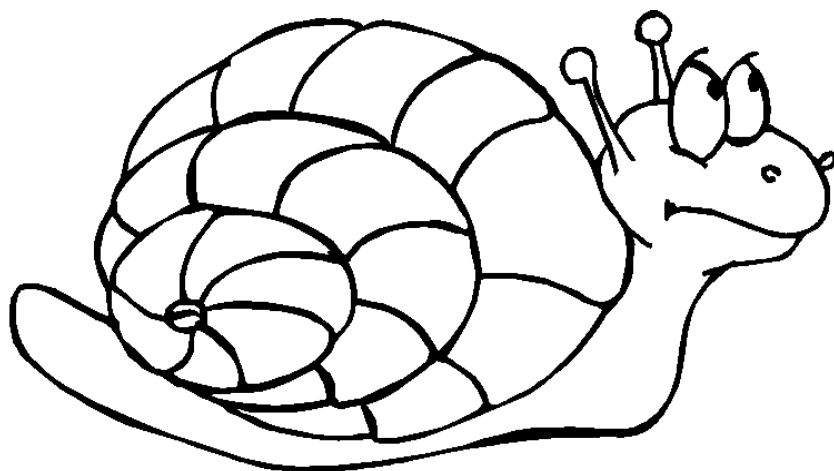
But when you forget that he's there,

Slowly up the wall.

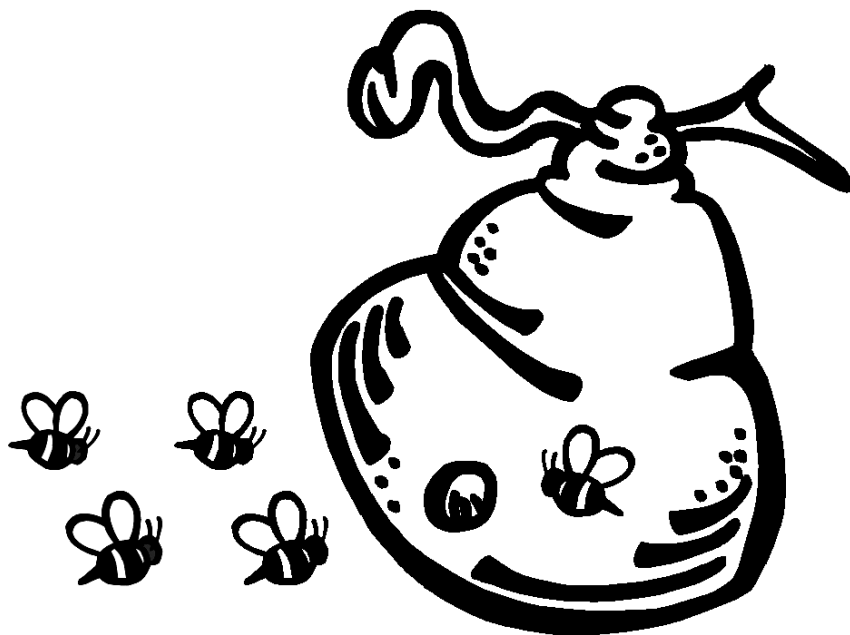
Snail

a wall

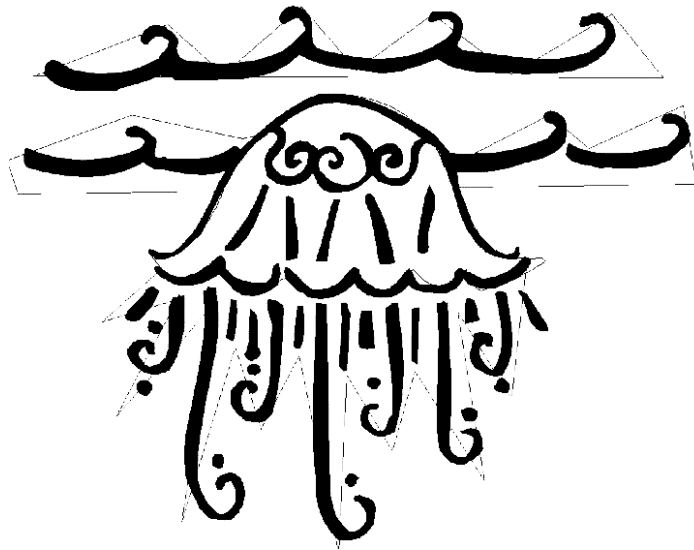
and never touch

all.



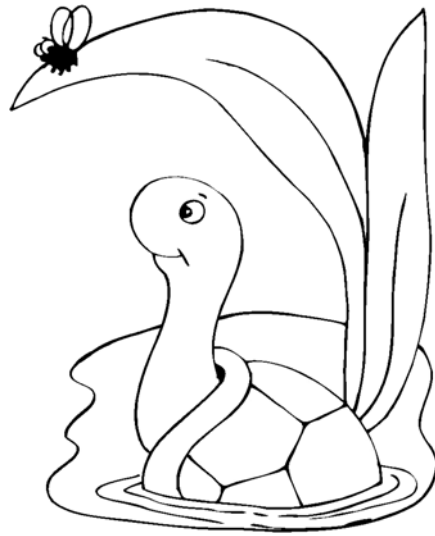
Jellyfish

I Want You To Meet

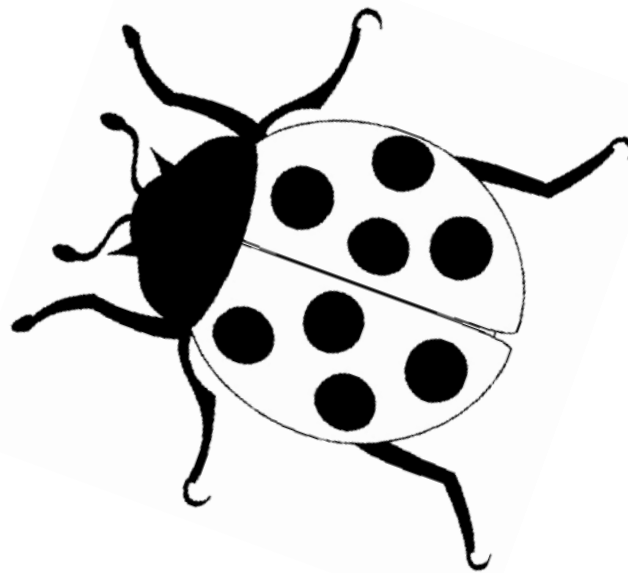
..... Meet ladybug,
